CRITERIA

- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application postmarked by **Friday, March 18, 2022**
- Applicants must complete a maximum 250 word essay.



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TIMELINE

- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by May 1, 2022

- Official school transcript in a sealed envelope from St. Peter Catholic School.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- A maximum 250 word essay.
- A letter of acceptance from St. Peter Catholic School or a Catholic high school.

- Award notification will be given by May 1, 2022.

Deadline for the application is Friday, **March 18, 2022.**
Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
