MERIT SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The St. Peter Scholarship Program awards partial tuition scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the St. Peter Scholarship Program Committee include, but are not limited to the following, *academic performance, leadership potential, good character, community service, volunteer hours and references.*

CRITERIA

1. Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by **April 15, 2026 (no exceptions).**
2. Students must be enrolled at St. Peter Catholic School or entering a Catholic high school to apply. **Merit Scholarships are for students entering grades 6-9 only.**
3. Refer to the application process for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.). Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.
5. Print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you.

You will be notified by phone or e-mail May 8, 2026 regarding the status of your application.

Scholarship funds are paid directly to the school. Should the student leave prior to finishing the school year, the funds remain with the school.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official school transcript in a sealed envelope from St. Peter Catholic School.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- Teacher Evaluation form – this form will be provided from the school office to the teacher for completion and submitted directly to the Scholarship Committee.
- If your child is changing schools, submit a letter of acceptance from St. Peter Catholic School or a Catholic High School.

Notifications will be made public by May 8, 2026.
