- **WHAT IS THE CRUSADER NEWSLETTER?**

- Electronic weekly newsletter from St. Peter Catholic School and Principal, Sheila Whalen.
- This is an excellent tool to learn about upcoming school events and information.
- Includes the school calendar.
- The Crusader is sent out by email; therefore, ensure correct emails are on file.

- **WHAT ARE STUDENT FOLDERS?**

- Student Homework Folders are maintained by the student for homework assignments.
- Yellow Family Folders are used for school communication and contain important information for the parents. If there is information that needs to be communicated, these folders will be sent home on Thursday with the student. Please return the folders the following day.
- Other School communications
 - Permission slips, order forms, etc.

- **WHY DO TEACHER SEND EMAILS?**

- To provide parents information about their child(ren) and class events.
- Feel free to reach out proactively to your child's teachers with any questions/concerns.

- Includes information for school delays and closures.

- Important information that is communicated via text message and voice message.
