- **WHAT IS THE CRUSADER NEWSLETTER?**
  - Electronic weekly newsletter from St. Peter Catholic School and Principal, Debbie Brook.
  - This is an excellent tool to learn about upcoming school events and information.
  - Includes the school calendar.
  - The Crusader is sent out by email; therefore, ensure correct emails are on file.
  
- **WHY DO TEACHERS SEND EMAILS?**
  - To provide parents information about their child(ren) and class events.
  - Feel free to reach out proactively to your child's teachers with any questions/concerns.
  
- **WHAT ARE EMAILS FROM "TEACHEREASE"?**
  - Important school information.
  - Includes information for school delays and closures.
  - These emails are sent by Carol Burns, the Office Administrative Director through [www.teacherease.com](http://www.teacherease.com). Please ensure the school has your correct email(s) on file.
  
- **WHAT IS SCHOOL MESSENGER?**
  - Important information that is communicated via text message and voice message.
  - Includes emergency information such as lock-outs, lock-ins, weather delays and/or closures.
  - These texts/voice messages are sent by Carol Burns, the Office Administrator and Debbie Brook, the school Principal.
  
- **OTHER FORMS OF COMMUNICATION:**
  - The school Website provides a News and Events section. The News and Events section lists upcoming events. You can locate this section under the drop down menu "About Us." Additionally, you can locate the school calendar in the "About Us" drop down menu under School Calendar/Facility Request.
  - The school does have a closed facebook page. Although social media is not used as a primary form of communication, there are often events and information posted on Facebook for those who choose to view. Note: Any important information parents need to be aware of will be sent out on teacherease.
