  - a. Mrs. Anderson motioned to approve the minutes from the August 9, 2023, meeting. Mrs. Thompson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- 4. SAC Updates
  - a. New Members

- (Mrs. Brook and Mr. Hammons)
- The SAC bylaws state: "Council shall consist of no fewer than seven (7) and no more than (11) voting members, the majority of whom shall be practicing Catholics."
- Four new people are interested in becoming member of the SAC Mr.
   Andrew Bussa, Ms. Victoria Goetz, Ms. Ann-Marie Jojola and Ms. Katie
   Torris. Based on the limitations of SAC member (11 voting members), the
   first three are being nominated by the current SAC as voting members.
- iii. Fr. Gregory will need to approve the final roster.
- iv. To accommodate more interest in the SAC, we could ask those who have been on the SAC more than 3 years to become non-voting members to

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make space for new members or we could amend the bylaws to increase the size of the voting membership.

- v. There is a proposal to amend the bylaws to include 11 people but to allow non-voting members who are on the roster to vote if there is not a quorum based on the 11 voting members.
- vi. The current roster will be reviewed for length of tenure to see who has exceeded threshold and Mrs. Brook and Mr. Hammons will make a recommendation for the October meeting.
- b. Officers
  - Positions on SAC are Chair (Mr. Hammons), Vice Chair (vacant) and Secretary (currently Ms. Kosiarek but looking for a new Secretary). Roles are described in the bylaws.
  - People are asked to pray about these opportunities and contact Mrs.
     Brook, Mr. Hammons and Karen Mrs. Kosiarek prior to the next meeting if interested. At the October meeting, the SAC will vote for Vice Chair and Secretary.
- c. Bylaws
  - i. The SAC will revisit and adopt the revised bylaws this year.
  - There are a few places where input is needed from Mrs. Whalen,
     Superintendent of Catholic Schools for the diocese. Mrs. Brook will review
     the revised bylaws with Mrs. Whalen on 9/19.
  - iii. After Mrs. Whalen's input it received, the proposed bylaws for voting will be circulated to all members.
- d. Training
  - Mrs. Whalen will training all new SAC members at 6pm at SPCS next Tuesday 9/19. If new members are not available at that time, contact Mrs. Brook for an option on another date at Ave Maria.

  There will not be a raffle at the boutique, but it will be later in the year and the proceeds will go to the school. The bake sale funds will go to the school for supplies and food for retreats, etc. Hopefully this is the solution moving forward.

  - a. Everything is ready for Friday 9/29. There are ~60 registrations for the adult party so far. The committee is reaching out to SMHS for volunteers at the carnival; middle school students might be asked to volunteer also. There will be a D.J. for kids and a live band for the adults.
